



## MCDCC Seeks Applicants to Serve on the Board of Elections

The Montgomery County Democratic Central Committee (MCDCC) seeks applications from individuals who wish to serve on the County Board of Elections. The MCDCC will vote to nominate 3 regular members and 1 substitute member at a special meeting to be held at **6 p.m., Monday, February 6, 2023**, at 12320 Parklawn Drive, Rockville, MD 20852. The meeting is open to the public.

To be eligible for appointment, an applicant must have been a registered voter in Montgomery County for the preceding 5 years. **The term of service is 4 years, beginning the first Monday of June 2023 until the first Monday of June 2027.** Individuals who are candidates for or are currently serving in public or party office are not eligible. Board of Elections members are prohibited from taking part in political activity during their term of office. Individuals nominated by the MCDCC are subject to appointment by the Governor and confirmation by the Maryland Senate.

The Montgomery County Board of Elections has 5 regular members and 2 substitute members. 3 regular members are appointed by the majority party, which is the political party of the incumbent Governor, and 2 regular members are appointed by the minority party. Each political party appoints 1 substitute member.

### HOW TO APPLY

Applicants must complete the online application at [www.govappointments.maryland.gov](http://www.govappointments.maryland.gov) no later than **5 pm, Tuesday, January 31, 2023**. Applicants must identify the desired appointment by selecting “Civil Rights & Voting” and then “Montgomery County Board of Elections” when completing the application.

Applicants should submit a resume, cover letter, and any other documentation that they would like MCDCC members to consider no later than **5 p.m., Friday, February 3, 2023**, by email to [office@mcdcc.org](mailto:office@mcdcc.org). with the subject line “Board of Elections Application.” Applicants will have the opportunity to speak and answer questions of MCDCC members at the public meeting.
